Lebanon Police Department Youth Police Academy

Thank you for your interest in the Lebanon Police Department's Youth Police Academy. The Youth Police Academy is one of a very few programs of its kind in the nation. Our hope is that the youth who participate in the program will develop an appreciation for law enforcement, build a strong rapport with our officers, and possibly spark an interest in future career paths in law, civics, or public service. Modeled after our successful Citizens' Police Academy, the Youth Police Academy is a week long program that entails lectures, presentations, and hands-on activities to teach and inform its students the many facets of law enforcement, leadership and teamwork skills, and the importance of being a good steward of the community.

The academy coincides with the Lebanon Special School District and Wilson County School District's spring and fall breaks. The academy runs Monday through Friday, starting at 8:30 a.m. and concludes at 4:00 p.m. The academy is provided at no cost.

Special instructions for YPA attendees:

- Wear loose, comfortable, clothing to all sessions. Physical activity will be encouraged.
- Wear gym shoes or comfortable shoes that will be conducive to physical activities.
- Be mindful that we will participate in outdoor activities, dress appropriate for conditions.
- Please remember to pack a sack lunch that can be disposed of daily. **No gum is allowed inside any buildings, vehicles, or facilities.**
- All materials will be provided.
- If the student is taking daily medication, we recommend taking those medications before or after the academy. If they must take medication during, you must list them on the application and are required to notify Corporal PJ Hardy prior to starting the academy.
- We encourage all attendees to actively participate, and most of all, have fun. We remind all participants to following instructions, obey rules, and respecting others during the academy.
