

WELCOME TO THE CITY OF LEBANON WATER DEPARTMENT

Lebanon's Water Department currently provides water to approximately 12,000 customers through a series of water mains ranging in size from 6" to 30". Our water source is the Cumberland River where water is taken and treated by our treatment facility located on Hwy. 231 North.

Responsibilities of the City of Lebanon Water Department

- Operate, maintain and repair 3,537 main line water valves, 1,625 fire hydrants and 223.88 miles of water main.
- Update and maintain GIS mapping of the City of Lebanon Water System including fire hydrants and valves.
- Flush and sample approximately 166 dead end fire hydrants in accordance with TDEC regulations.
- Locate the systems water mains and service lines as required by Tennessee One Call.
- Operate and maintain 6 water storage tanks and 5 water booster stations.
- Maintain an ongoing water meter change-out program.
- Evaluate and coordinate the Cross-Connection Program as set forth by TDEC Rules and Regulations.
- Respond to an average of 175 work orders monthly.
- Work with the City of Lebanon's consultants to continue to improve the quality of water we distribute by replacing older lines throughout the City of Lebanon.
- The Water Distribution Dept. is made up of thirteen (13) employees: one (1) Manager, one (1) Field Operations Supt., one (1) Support Specialist, one (1) Crew Leader, and nine (9) Field Workers.
